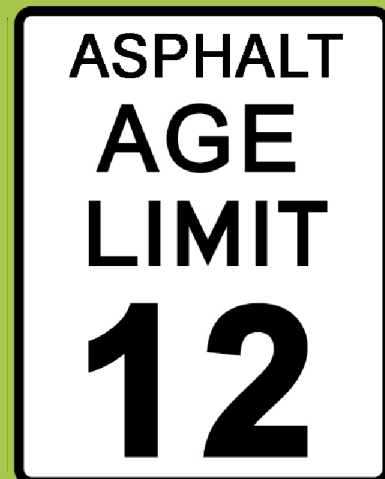

## Who says you have to obey age limits?

Asphalt pavements require resurfacing every 8 to 14 years in addition to continual patching and sealing every 2 to 4 years. That's in sharp contrast to concrete. Many concrete pavements average 25 to 30 years before requiring any maintenance. Most concrete pavements don't need resurfacing for 30, 40 or even 50 years.

That's because most building materials start deteriorating the moment they are placed, but not concrete. Concrete actually gets stronger with age. That's why it's not unusual to find concrete pavements like Interstate 55 in Copiah County, MS that have outlived their design life cycle and have had little to no maintenance. Wow.
