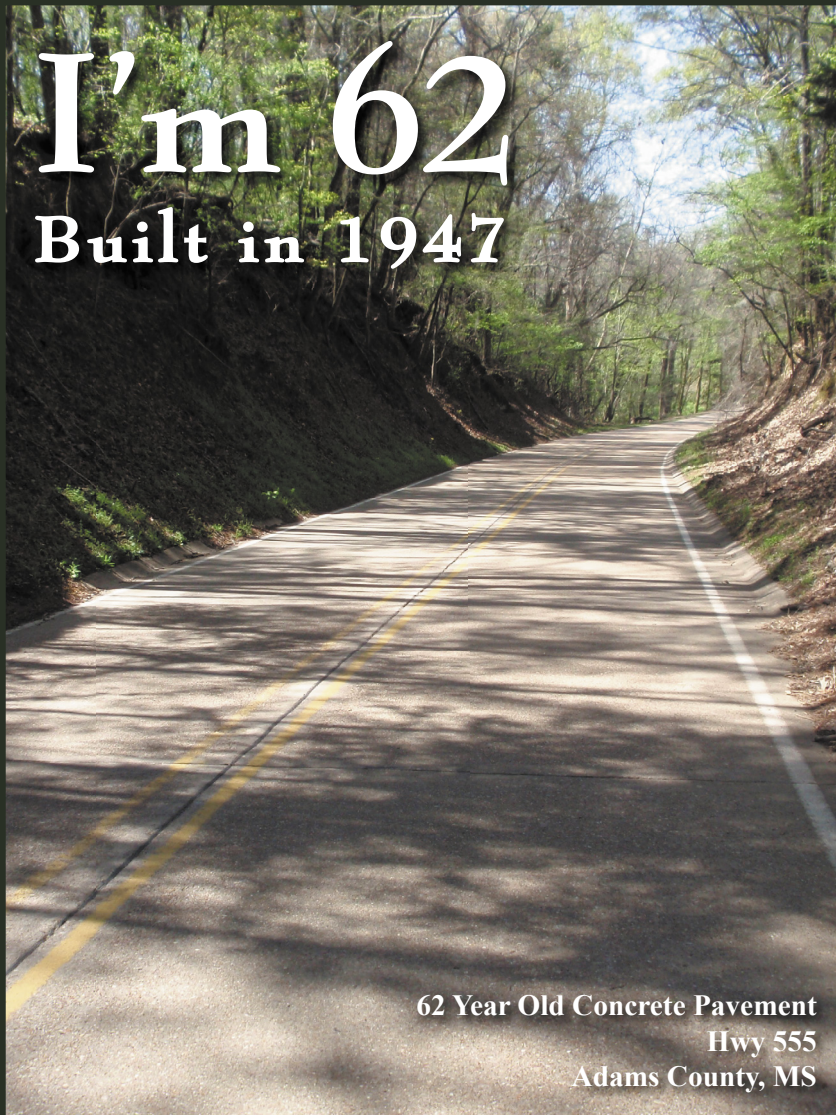

Concrete pavements last longer. There are many concrete pavements, just like this section of Highway 555 just outside of Natchez, that have significantly outlived their designed life. When you don't have to mill up and replace the top few inches of a pavement every 8 to 14 years - it is easy to see why it is the greenest choice. Just think of all that wasted effort, time, construction fuel, exhaust and extra traffic from workzones. Speaking of wasted fuel, concrete pavements also use less fuel during initial construction - about 1/5 as much.

Concrete pavement's lighter color also helps you be green by reflecting light. Lighter pavements improve night time visibility and require less lighting fixtures. Lighter pavements also reduce urban-heat island effects where a city's temperature can become as much as 10 degrees hotter than the surrounding countryside. Of course, these are just a few of the many reasons why concrete pavements make it easy to be green.
